



Meadowlane Shopping Centre



- 01 Moneymore Road Entrance 02 Site Layout Drawing showing existing & extension 03 Site Photograph –Entrance






Mixed use development of retail and offices over. Sitting in a very conservative townscape on a tight little infill site.





This shopping Centre originally designed by Coogan & Co. has been extended four times. With car parking for the additional retail space being provided in multi-level car parks.

A superb entrance facade piece incorporates integrated signage and a modern portico marks the approach and works well with the new pedestrian footbridge.

The palette of materials of the previous phase is used. This scheme provides another 7000 SqM retail space.


Erneside Shopping Centre - Phase 4


